## **Seesaw Family Guide**

Seesaw is the online learning platform that John Clifford School is using for all children to support remote learning. Children will receive instruction, complete tasks, and submit work for feedback if they are asked to remain at home to self-isolate. Each student at John Clifford will receive a Home Learning Code for Seesaw. This will be glued into your child's Communication Diary. Step 1: Install the Seesaw Class App Link to downloads: <a href="https://web.seesaw.me/platforms">https://web.seesaw.me/platforms</a> If you are using a personal home device, which is a tablet or phone, download or update the Seesaw Class app in your device's app store. The most recent version of Seesaw is required for home learning.  If your home device is a laptop or computer, visit app.seesaw.me.	CLASS Seesaw Class
<b>Step 2:</b> Find the <b>HOME LEARNING QR CODE</b> that will be sent home by your child's teacher. Help your child log in the first time using this code. If you have multiple children, each child will have their own unique code. If they are using a shared device, they will have to "log off" when switching between accounts. **Step 5:** Children should check in daily for their assigned tasks, which will form part of their ongoing curriculum. There will be assigned activities in subject areas each day, as well as videos or presentations of lessons posted. Children can complete these at their own pace and then submit them to their teacher in the Seesaw Class App.
