Getting busy during the day

- Registration and carpet time.
- Daily maths sessions.
- Daily phonics sessions.
- Small group tasks – writing, reading, maths, creative.
- Child initiated learning indoors and outdoors.
- Whole class sessions, including: stories, circle time, handwriting, singing, dancing, PE, topic.

Help your child to be school ready by practising:

- Putting coats on and doing them up.
- Getting dressed and undressed.
 - Using knives and forks.
- Going to the toilet, flushing and washing hands.
 - Recognising and writing own name.
 - Read stories together.
 - Help to recognise numbers.
 - Sharing and turn taking.
 - Listening to grown ups.
- Tidying up and looking after belongings.
