Year 2 Visited a Victorian Christmas at Newstead Abbey

The children in YR2 travelled back in time to 1898, to the first Christmas time celebrated, at the then brand-new John Clifford School (Nether Street School). The children and staff looked amazing in their Victorian outfits, as they climbed aboard the not so Victorian double decker bus heading off to the Newstead Abbey, which was beautifully decorated around the theme of 'Snowed in at Newstead Abbey'.

The children then turned back the clock in school to 22nd November 1898. The day began with reading, writing and arithmetic, with the desks in rows, chalk and slates, dunces caps, fingernail and hair checks and lots of rote learning. The afternoon saw the children making peg dolls, decoupage and cups and balls. We finished the day with a sing song in the hall. A fun day was had by all. A big thank you to the children and parents of Lavender and Rosemary classes and the YR2 and office team for their support.



Year 3 Visited Creswell Crags

Year 3 travelled to Cresswell with many additional layers and waterproofs! The journey was smooth and after what felt like 100 renditions of our year group Christmas songs they finally arrived. The children were split into our two tribes; The Woolly Rhinos and The Cave Bears and each took part in three workshops during the day – Stone Age Safari, Survival Skills and a Life in the Ice Age Cave Tour. The workshops were delivered by our Ice Age Experts who were astounded by the high level of understanding the children had of the time period. Each of these workshops supported the learning that the children have been accessing in school – from using our knowledge of the human body to rebuild animal skeletons (which were among some of the best they have even seen!) to launching Ice Age spears to hunt Bison. A great trip that was much enjoyed.
