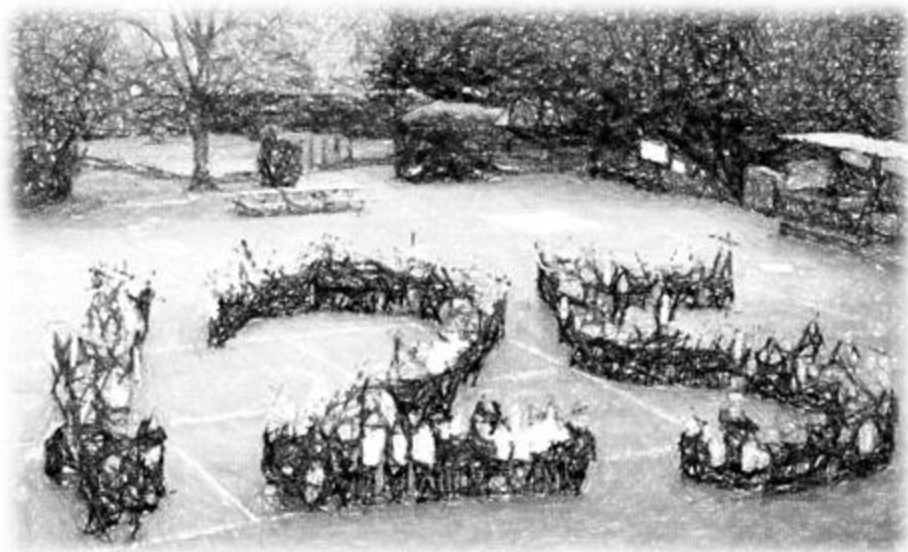
John Clifford School
