Interested in applying for a bursary-assisted place?

As you may know, Nottingham High School offers a limited amount of bursary-assisted places for new students. These are available for Year 7 entry only, and are means-tested based on parent income and your child's performance in the Entrance Exam.

Bursary FAQs

How do I apply for a bursary-assisted place?

1. Submit the school's Application Form, and tick the relevant box to express your interest in a bursary, by the deadline of **1st November 2025**.
2. Complete the school's Online Bursary Application Form (sent after the deadline), to give us further details of your financial circumstances.
3. Be available for a Home Visit, which is conducted by our Bursary Team during the first two weeks of December.

When will I know if my child has been offered an assisted place?

Your child will be invited to sit the Year 7 Entrance Exam, which is taking place on **Saturday 17th January 2026**.

The top-performing candidates who have applied for a bursary will be invited back to the school for an Entrance Interview, along with their parents/guardians.

Offer letters will then be sent on Friday 6th February 2026, with replies to be with the school by Monday 2nd March 2026.
