YR3 Trip to Creswell Craggs Wednesday 26th November 2025

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our **Stone Age to Iron Age** topic, we are taking the children in Violet and Snowdrop class to Creswell Craggs an education centre outside the village of Creswell in Derbyshire. Creswell Craggs is an enclosed limestone gorge and the cliffs in the ravine contain several caves that were occupied during the last ice age, between around 43,000 and 10,000 years ago.

The children will take part in three activities during the day, a Stone Age Safari, Life in the Ice Age (cave Tour) and survival skills training. As the caves and some of the workshops are outdoors, your child will require weather-suitable clothing and firm footwear with a strong grip. (Warm trousers/jogging bottoms, T-shirt, John Clifford sweatshirt or cardigan, warm coat, hat and gloves) The cost of this trip is **£19.15** and this includes the hire of the bus and the day's activities at Creswell Craggs.

We will be needing some parent / carer helpers to assist with the visit (we regret that younger siblings cannot be accommodated on this trip). If you are interested in helping, please contact your Class Teacher or the School Office.
