Year 5 Bikeability Training

Monday 9th February, Tuesday 10th February, Wednesday 11th February, Thursday 12th February and Friday 13th February

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are offering the Bikeability training program for Year 5, which will equip your child with the knowledge and awareness to ride a bike safely. This will involve sessions both on the playground and on the road under the supervision of John Clifford School staff and trained bike instructors. The Bikeability training will be delivered by First Grade Sports and you can find out more on their website:

The sessions will take place on Monday 9th February, Tuesday 10th February, Wednesday 11th February, Thursday 12th February and Friday 13th February with children cycling in small groups at different times of the school day. When not taking part in cycling, children will be working in school as usual.

To take part in the Bikeability course, your child will need:

- to be able to ride a bike without help,
- a <u>roadworthy bicycle</u> with working brakes, pumped up tyres and a saddle at the correct height (please see the notes attached for further details on this). Children who do not have a bike may be able to borrow one from a friend.
- a <u>bicycle helmet</u> marked with your child's name (we can loan a helmet from school if you do not have one)
- a <u>waterproof coat</u> and gloves in case of cold/ wet weather. Uniform should be worn to school as normal, but jogging bottoms or tracksuit trousers may be worn if desired for cycling.

Certificates and badges will be awarded to all children completing the course.
